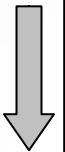

NICHOLAS KRISTOFF, is the grandson of Polish/Armenian US immigrants and a Harvard graduate with a law degree from Magdalen College of Oxford. He is a journalist who has won two Pulitzer Prizes, and nominated for many more. [Half the Sky](#) reached #1 on the best seller lists. The Washington Post’s Carolyn Sees said, “...[Half the Sky](#) is a call to arms...a call for help...” asking, “...us to open our eyes to the enormous humanitarian issues of sex trafficking, forced prostitution, contemporary slavery, and gender-based violence and rape used as weapons of war ...shining a light on the multitude of ways women of the world are oppressed and violated.

- **GARY HAUGEN**, who is the founder of **International Justice Mission** and the former director of UN investigations into the aftermath of the Rwandan genocide. **IJM** is a global rights agency that protects the poor by partnering with local authorities and enforcement to rescue victims, bring criminals to justice, restore survivors, and strengthen justice systems.
