



Today church will be lead by the youth of our church. It is an exciting day for them to help lead songs, prayers, and even the sermon. A great verse to know from the Bible is:

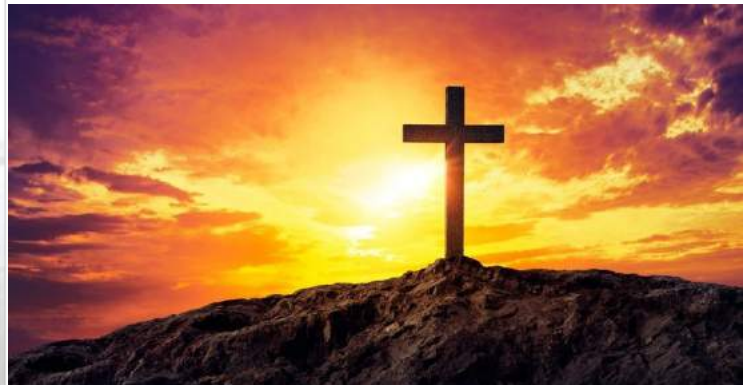

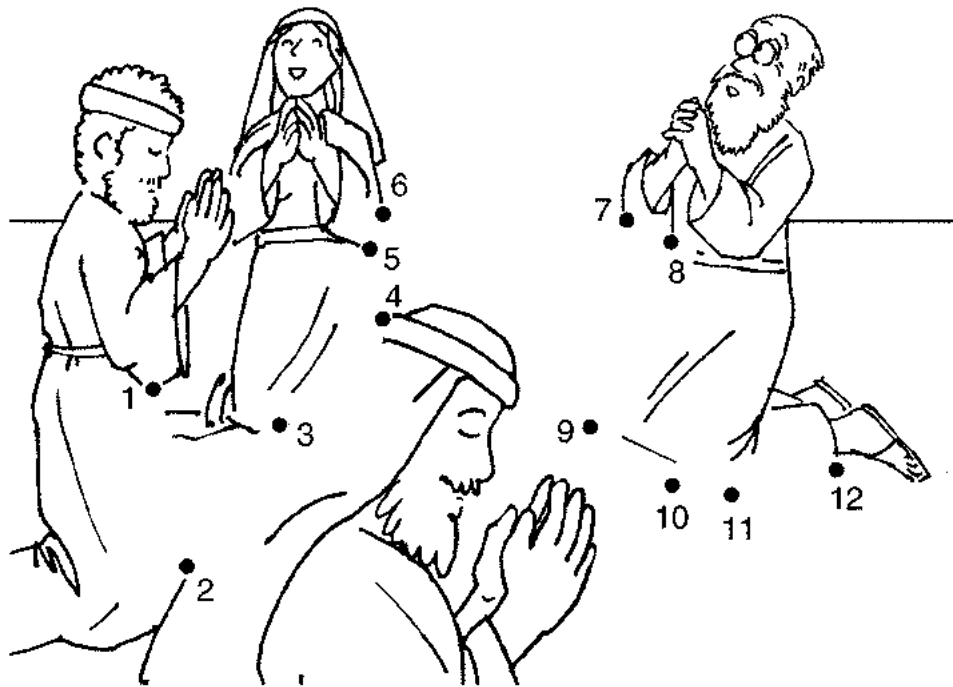

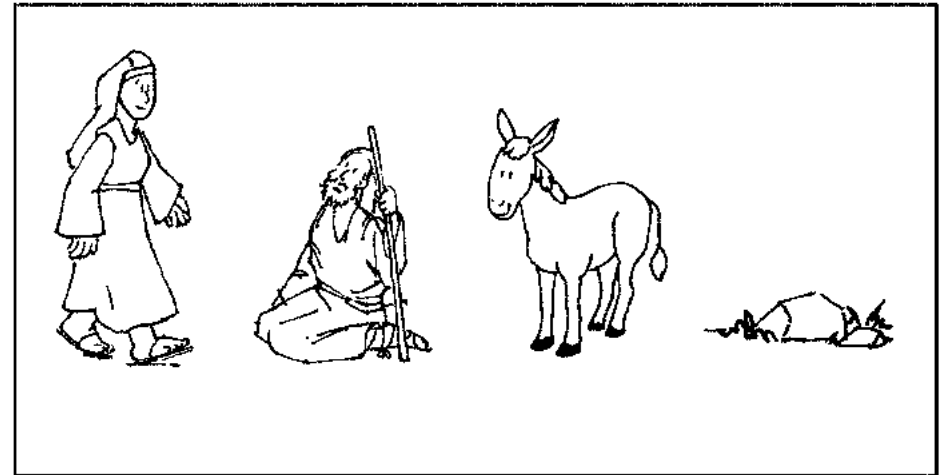


“Repent ... and turn to God so that your sins may be wiped out.”

Circle the man who cannot walk.

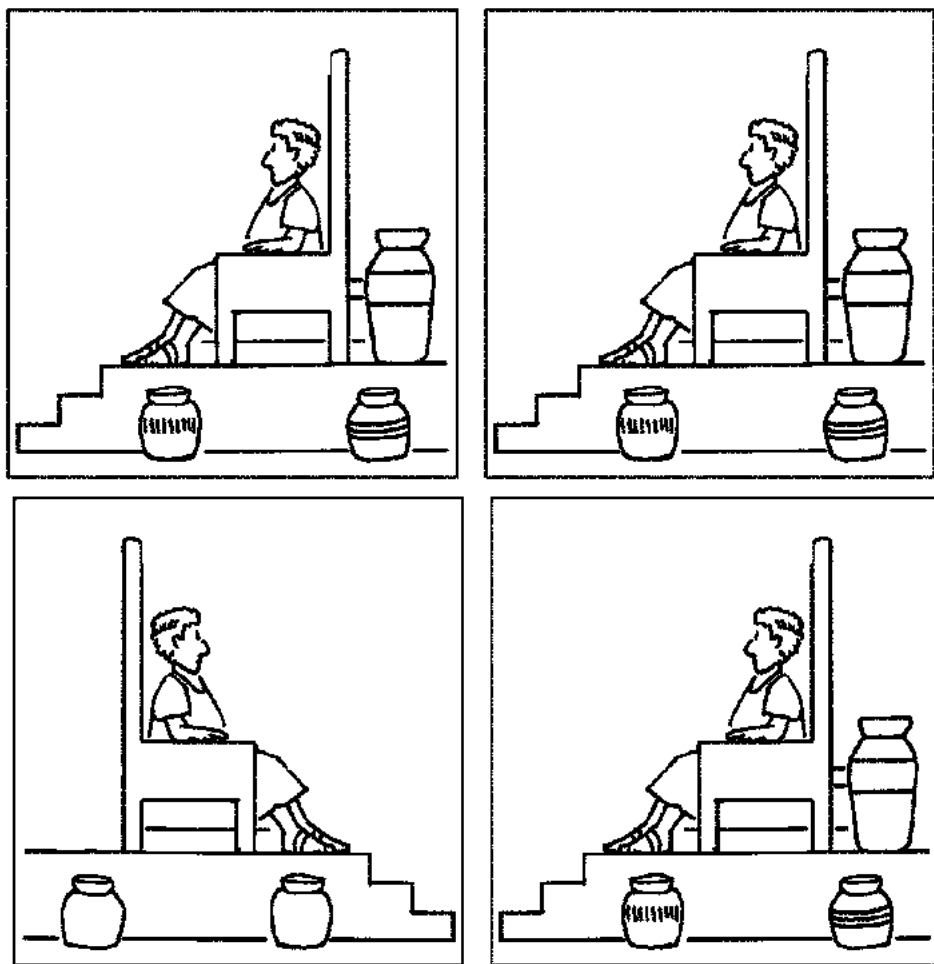


... as if by our own power or faith we had made this man walk?”

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Peter said God had made His servant Jesus holy. But the people handed Jesus over to Pilate.

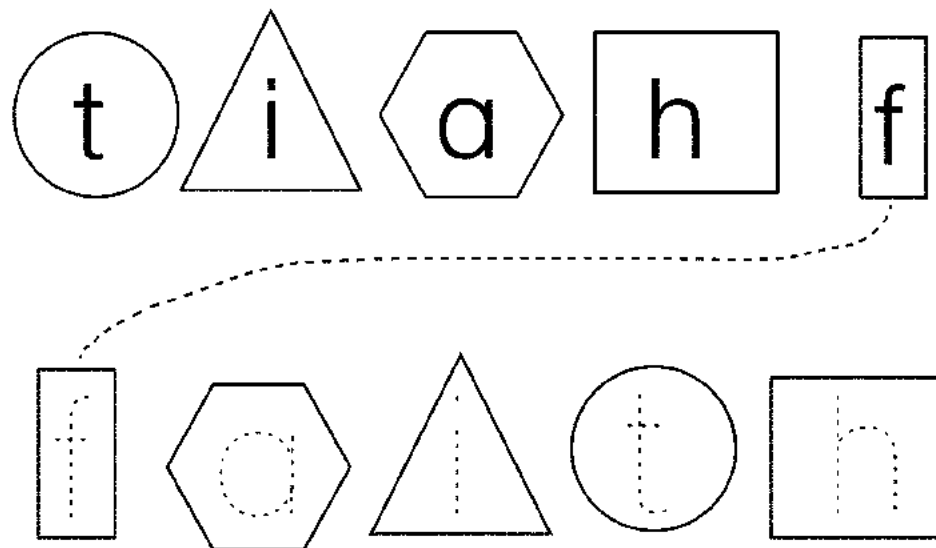
Circle the picture of Pilate that is different.

“The faith that comes through Him has completely healed him, as you can all see.”

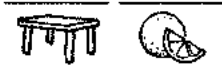

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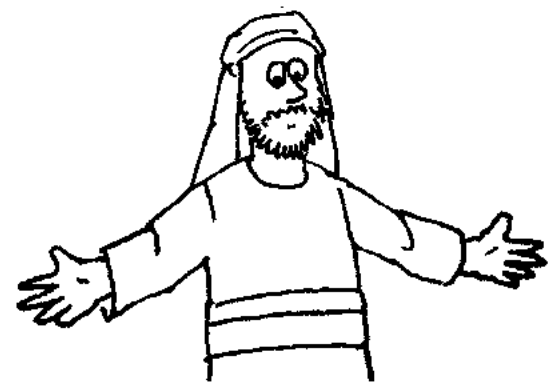
